



What is MAT?

Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) are prescription drugs that can help manage withdrawal, pain, relieve cravings, prevent you from getting high, or make you sick if you try. Some people find a lower level of rush or euphoria easier to manage, for others it's a way to prevent or reduce withdrawal symptoms. Some people prefer MAT drugs because they are regulated so they don't have to worry about what's been cut into them. **MAT drugs are a tool that helps manage our relationships with drugs.**

Examples of MAT

Opioids

**METHADONE /
DOLPHINE /
METHADOSE**

Eliminates withdrawals, relieves cravings, and manages pain. Can include euphoria.

**BUPRENORPHINE /
SUBOXONE /
SUBLOCADE**

Reduces cravings and withdrawal without producing euphoria

Alcohol

**ACAMPROSATE /
CAMPRAL**

Reduces cravings and withdrawal symptoms

**DISULFIRAM /
ANTABUSE:**

Causes hang-over-like effects when alcohol is used

**NALTREXONE
/ VIVITROL:**

Prevents the positive effects of alcohol and opioids

Stimulants

**LISDEXAMFETAMINE /
VYVANSE:**

Reduces cravings and withdrawals from amphetamines
